FoKL extends a hearty welcome to the newlyformed Cardinal Friends of the Wetmore Library, who received a FoKL start-up grant in October, 2023.

Although the Goff/Wetmore service area is small (population 500), Wetmore has an attractive, active public library that is prized in the community. A golf tournament, expansion and improvement of the Library Park, outdoor movies, as well as Storytimes and other inlibrary activities are just a part of what makes this a welcoming hub.

The Cardinal Friends formed to assist and further the programs, to provide a volunteer base, and to conduct fundraising efforts for the library. Janet Suther said in the start-up grant application, "As of this fall, Wetmore has lost its school so it is more important than ever that the library step up to play a vital role in the community." The application asked for funds to send out a mass mailing to the community asking for membership and support for the Friends group.

Since then, the group has been busy. One of the first actions was to form a board, which includes Janet Suther (President), Joe Claycamp (Vice-President), Mark Goodman (Treasurer), Regina Mayer (Secretary), Alex Lara-Thompson (Creative Director), Anne Rowland, Callie Bloom, Katie Heinen, and Kristina Rice (Director, Wetmore Public Llbrary).

Focusing on the business side, the group has applied for and received an EIN number and has also applied for 501(c)(3) status.

The process of recruiting members is ongoing. In addition to the mailing, the group has created an inviting and attractive Facebook Page that says "Join us as we raise money for Wetmore Public Library programs, budget, and collections." They also set up a membership recruitment table at the community "Miracle on 2nd Street" event after Thanksgiving.

In February, the group will host a Trivia night with Linda Boyd as Guest Emcee.
